

Swim Lesson Registration

Beginning in fall 2011 all students who have not participated in Y Swim lessons will be asked to start in the beginner level of swimming for their age category, or participate in a swim evaluation to identify their correct swim level.

Swimmers who have taken swim lessons over the past year should be coded in the computer for the swim level they should be entering. To confirm your child's information is correct sign into online registration, go to my family and select the participant. When you've selected your participant click on my information and the swim level should be listed near their birth date. If your child has taken swim classes and is not coded or is coded incorrectly, please call Maureen Smeltz, Aquatics Director at 484-921-5846 or email MSmeltz@fymca.org to correct the error. Please attend to this prior to registration. Flags will now be set in our computer system that will not allow you to register your child for a class higher than the level they are coded (i.e. if your child is coded Eel they will be able to register for Pike A, Pike B, Eel, but not Ray or Starfish).

We are excited about using our computer system to help you track your child's progress. We hope using our computer system will allow your child to have a more positive experience as it will prevent children being misplaced in our advanced classes. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
